  - Restaurant experiences/Serving styles
  - Food-service related career opportunities within country

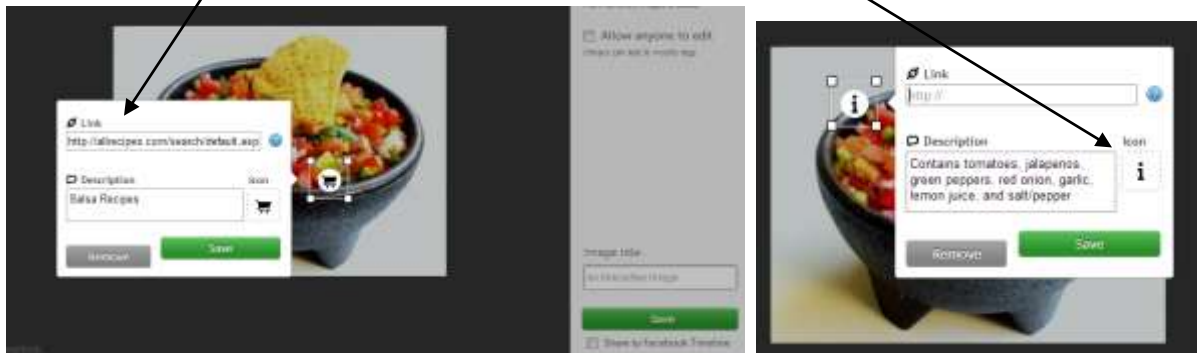
5. Create a profile or log into [ThingLink](#)
