Be Responsible	<p>Attend class daily and be on time (two feet in the door).</p> <p>Use passing period to stop at the restroom or your locker.</p> <p>Get a pass if you are running late or if you need to leave.</p> <p>Be prepared and have work completed when arriving to class.</p>	<p>Be an active participant by taking notes, asking questions, and participating when it's appropriate.</p> <p>Come ready to learn.</p> <p>Bring required materials to class.</p>	<p>When choosing partners, pick partners with whom you know you can be productive and successful.</p> <p>Be prepared to work so that you can get the most out of your time with your group.</p> <p>Do what you say you will when you say you will do it.</p> <p>Be prepared to do your share.</p>	<p>Get assignments ahead of time if you know you'll be gone.</p> <p>When absent due to sickness or other unforeseen event, be proactive about finding out what you missed by asking the teacher and/or students as soon as possible during your class period or study hall.</p> <p>Turn in absent work and/or make up tests/quizzes within allotted time (2 days for every day of absence).</p>	<p>Use your time wisely (don't pack up early).</p> <p>Use labs and their equipment for their intended use, including following all safety protocols</p> <p>Report any damage to the teacher.</p> <p>Read all directions and follow instructions provided by your instructor</p>	<p>If you need to borrow materials they are checked out with the teacher.</p> <p>Keep track of any materials you use and return them promptly when you have finished with them, checking them in with the instructor and then promptly returning to their original location.</p> <p>Report any damages to materials, furniture, or the room to the teacher.</p>	<p>Electronic devices are used appropriately (for educational purposed, not for watching movies, texting, or playing games)</p> <p>Music may be listened to only after assignments or tests/quizzes are completed and turned in upon approval from the instructor.</p> <p>Cell phones and other devices cannot be charged during instruction unless being used for classroom purposes.</p>
